



EASY TO MAKE RABBIT TOYS

THAT BUNNIES WILL LOVE!



Long kitchen towel inner cardboard tubes.

CARDBOARD TUBE TOYS

THESE MAKE A GREAT THROW TOY!



Create a little hole in the middle and fold up the cardboard to make a tag for them to get hold of.



Choose a selection of their favourite treats & place them in the middle of the tube.



Keep the tube flat & stuff each end with hay to secure the treats in the middle. *Done!*



Short toilet roll inner cardboard tubes.



Choose a small selection of your bunny's favourite treats & a little hay.



Place the treats in the middle & stuff a little hay each side of the treats



Stuff brown paper or news paper in each end of the tube. *Done!*

CARDBOARD BOTTLE CARRIER TOY WITH HIDDEN TREATS



These cardboard bottle carriers are available from most supermarkets.



Break the straps so that the gaps are bigger to place items in. Also stops the risk of your rabbit getting their head stuck in the gaps.



Place some scrunched up brown paper in the bottom of the carrier.



Place some of your rabbits favourite treats amongst the scrunched up paper.



Then place another layer of scrunched up brown paper on top to hide the treats. Done!

EGG BOX TOY FILLED WITH TREATS



Use a plain cardboard egg box. If there are any stickers, remove them.



Place a few tiny pieces of treats in the box. We used tiny pieces of carrot, apple & a broken up fenugreek crunchie.



Then place a little fresh & dried herbs into the box. We used fresh parsley & dried dandelion.



Place a small handful of hay on top of the treats.



And close the box. Done!

ITEMS YOU WILL NEED *OR ANYTHING SIMILAR WILL DO TOO!*



Egg boxes



Cardboard tubes



Cardboard bottle carriers



Small cardboard box



Brown paper



Good quality hay



Dried herbs



Healthy treats



Carrot: small pieces or peelings



Fresh Parsley



Apple: small pieces only



Dandelions

CARDBOARD BOX TOY *FULL OF HIDDEN GOODIES!*



A small to medium sized box is best. Remove any sticker or tape from the box. Close one end of the box by overlapping the sides until secure. Do not use tape. The idea is your rabbit can get into the box easily.



Place scrunched up brown paper at the bottom of the box.



Place a choice of your rabbits favourite treats amongst the paper. You can also add other items, like hay cakes, or the small cardboard tube toys.



Place more scrunched up brown paper on the top & close the box by overlapping the sides to secure.



Create some holes around the sides, so your rabbit can smell what is inside and use these to demolish the box. *Done!*
